

Walnut Township Trustees Special Meeting – Final

Tuesday, July 25, 2018

In Attendance: Trustees: Terry Horn and Bill Yates; Patricia McLoughlin, Recording Secretary and one (1) guest.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of this meeting was to revise the wording for the 3 Mil road improvement levy on the November 2018 ballot. This is also a time for the public to provide input.

Trustee Yates met with Joshua Horecek at the Prosecutor’s office to secure the appropriate language for this levy to be placed on the ballot.

This was the last opportunity for the Township to hear from the public or to change their minds about this road levy. The Trustees wanted to make sure the public has fully been informed and there would be no surprises. Joshua Horecek informed Trustee Yates that this levy would exclude the incorporated residents of the township, but includes all residents outside of all corporation limits.

This Levy would be a continuing 3 Mil levy and have the potential to raise \$562,000 per year based on current assessed tax evaluation of \$187,996.020. The dollar amount will not increase, however, once certified, the tax evaluation could go up or down.

Horn motioned to proceed to place a 3Mil levy on the November 2018 ballot. Yates seconded. Roll call:

Horn – yes, Yates, - yes. Motion passed with two (2) yes votes.

Horn moved to close the meeting, Yates seconded, motion passed with two (2) yes votes.

Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.
