Discussion Summary	Action/Decision/Follow-Up
<p>This meeting is for the purpose to discuss Walnut Township's 2021 proposed budget.</p> <p>Jane reported that she decreased the revenue due to a 30% reduction over the past two months in intergovernmental money. She presented the budget and informed the Trustees they have until the 8/3/2020 meeting to make any changes or additions to the presented budget.</p> <p>She said she would like to find out how much money is being held back on non-certified monies. Doug suggested she contact Ed Laramie to provide her that information.</p> <p>Jane is awaiting the property tax monies for this month, what amount will be certified.</p> <p>She said that the street funds are taking the biggest hit on the budget this year. Trustee Leith asked about the 2231 special assessment revenue and why it went from approximately \$60,019 to \$167,000 in 2021. This is the fund balance YTD in special revenue. That is the carryover fund revenue so that we haven't used that money out of that fund in a long time, and those funds could also be used for paving. Jane verified with Josh from the County.</p> <p>Jane said that funds are increasing from zoning this year</p>
